On Malin's first two solo albums, he played the depressive barfly wondering where it all went wrong, but on *Glitter In The Gutter*, things go right. Rockers like "In The Modern World" will sound great blaring from a jukebox, and his duet with The Boss on "Broken Radio" is poignant without being mopey. Malin's not really reinventing the wheel here, but he's taking it for a nice trip.
