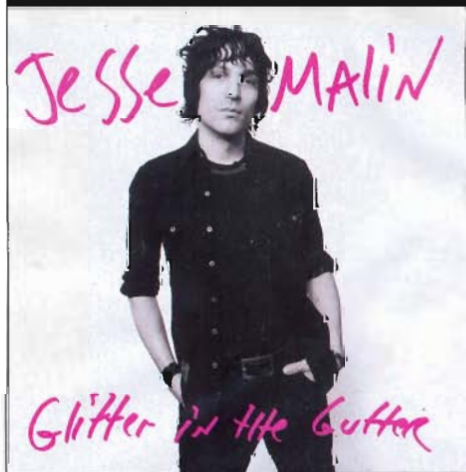

Jesse Malin and Ryan Adams seem like a perfect pair — two NYC rocker dudes with equally strong tastes for punk, pop and country (not to mention cigarettes and booze) who can put all three genres together like they're one and the same. For his third solo album, *Glitter in the Gutter*, Malin recruited Adams (who produced Malin's solo debut *The Fine Art of Self Destruction*) to add guitar and vocals to a handful of tracks. While Malin, formerly of glam-punk band D Generation, spends most of the album in pop-rock mode, *Glitter's* best song is an orchestrated, piano-ballad duet ("Broken Radio") that has Malin trading verses with none other than Bruce Springsteen. Queens of the Stone Age's Josh Homme ("Tomorrow Tonight"), Foo Fighters' Chris Shiflett ("Prisoners of Paradise") and The Wallflowers' Jakob Dylan ("Black Haired Girl") also lend their talents, but none of the cameos hold a candle to The Boss. — Flip Griswold
