The members of We Are The Fury have been playing together since 1999. In their native Ohio, they became staples of the local music scene, but in 2004 the group took stock of where they wanted to go with the music. "Some of us were in college," says singer Jeremy Lublin, "maybe headed in other directions. But we wanted to stay together, and try to make a living out of it."

That pow-wow led to a new direction for the band. They wrote a bunch of new songs and overhauled their sound. "We booked a lot of out-of-town shows," says Lublin. Then, one night in Las Vegas, a magic moment happened. "I was at a Head Automatica show, and I asked someone with the band if I could pass our demo on to Daryl [Palumbo, lead singer], and then there's Daryl, and he wanted to listen to it right then and there!"

That meeting led to We Are the Fury touring with Head Automatica, which led to label interest. Lublin and bandmates were invited to Los Angeles to showcase in 2005. The band set up the dates on their own, and had a management company at that time that they have since severed ties with. "We really wanted to sign with an indie and not a straight major label, but an indie label that had know-how behind it, that was One Big Spark / EastWest. We wanted to hit the road running, and build a fan base. We love touring." The band was also impressed by the fact that Purevolume.com was behind One Big Spark. "You can't ignore the power of the internet these days, and they know how to use it."

We Are The Fury signed for a three-album deal with One Big Spark / EastWest. Their EP was released in 2006, with the full-length CD scheduled for a late May release.
