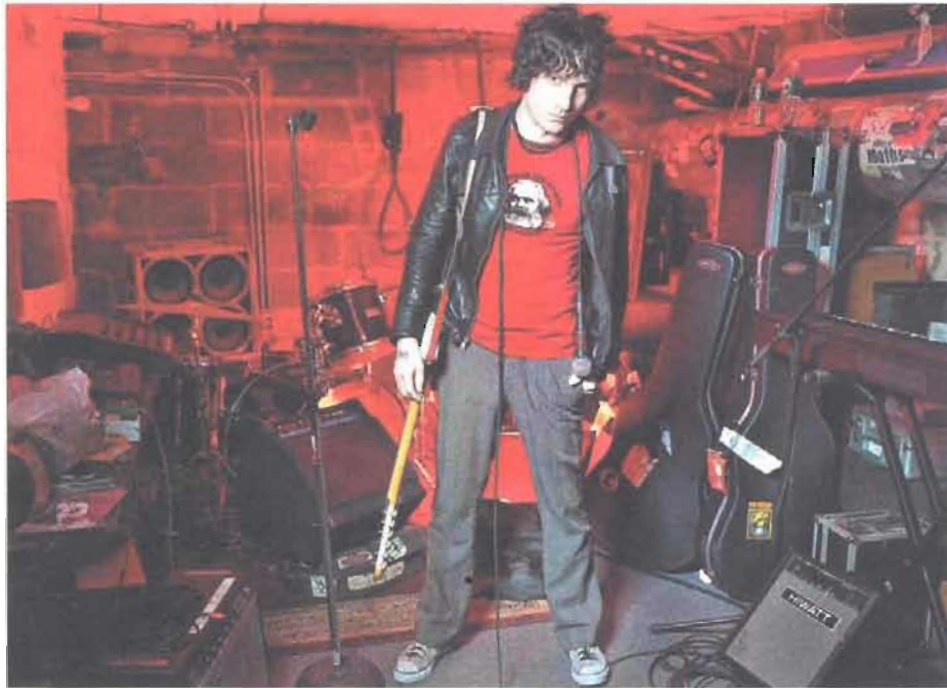

Next generation

The New York City scene lost one of its most beloved rock bands when D Generation broke up in 1999, but the world gained a gritty rock troubadour in 2003 when frontman Jesse Malin (above) re-emerged with his debut solo album, "The Fine Art of Self De-

struction." Malin may have even more fans now than in D Generation's heyday, at least among his fellow musicians. His latest, "Glitter in the Gutter," boasts guest spots by Ryan Adams, Bruce Springsteen, Jakob Dylan, and Josh Homme of Queens of the Stone Age. Despite the all-star line-up, "Glitter" is a no frills, straight-ahead rock album in an era when everyone is a hybrid or a hyphen.
