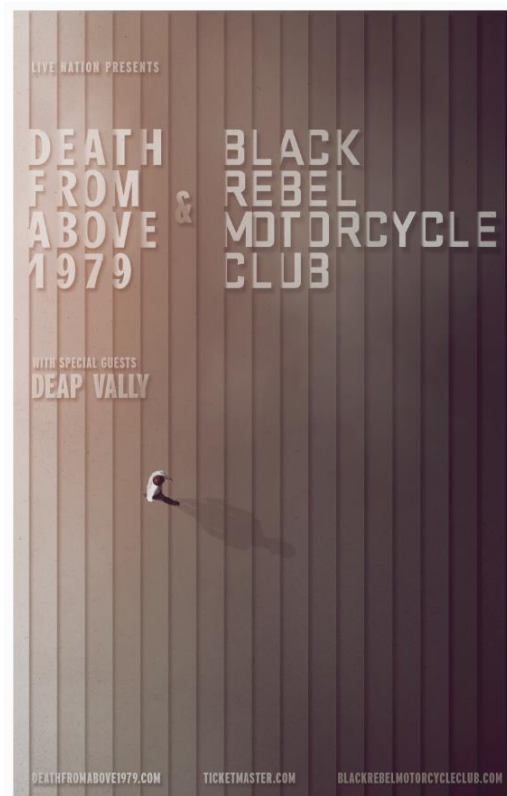




**DEATH FROM ABOVE ANNOUNCES FALL CO-HEADLINING TOUR WITH
