### DJ Khaled Hits Top Of Billboard Chart

This week on the music charts, DJ Khaled (right) beat Imagine Dragons to No. 1, and Prince returns to the Top 5 with a reissue of "Purple Rain." "Grateful" (We the Best/Epic), the latest by DJ Khaled, opened at No. 1 on the Billboard album chart with the equivalent of 149,000 sales in the United States, including 50,000 copies sold as a full album, according to Nielsen. "Grateful" has guest appearances on almost every track, by the likes of Drake, Beyoncé and Jay-Z, and gives particular prominence to DJ Khaled's infant son, Asahd: In addition to appearing on the cover, the 8-month-old Asahd is also listed as executive producer.

"Grateful" narrowly beat "Evolve" (KIDinaKORNER/Interscope), by Imagine Dragons, which had the equivalent of 147,000 sales, in a different mix of formats: 109,000 copies of "Evolve" were sold as full albums, and it had fewer streams than DJ Khaled's album had.

"Purple Rain" (NPG/Warner Bros.) re-entered the chart this week at No. 4. Also on the chart, Kendrick Lamar's "DAMN." is No. 3, and 2 Chainz's "Pretty Girls Like Trap Music" falls three spots to No. 5 in its second week. Lorde, who was No. 1 last week, fell to No. 13 this week.

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
