Band members Brann Dailor, Bill Kelliher, and Brent Hinds portrayed White Walkers in the final episode of the season, "The Dragon and the Wolf," which aired last night, August 27. This marks the second time Mastodon has been invited to participate as extras in *Game of Thrones* by the show's creator and executive producer, Dan Weiss.
