Last night, The Head And The Heart kicked off their North American tour at New York’s Central Park SummerStage, and today they’ve released their dazzling rendition of “Don’t Dream It’s Over” by Crowded House. The track is available for purchase and streaming [HERE](#).

This Fall, the band are hitting the road with The Shelters, performing to audiences in Philadelphia, DC, Nashville and more. They’ll also make a stop at the famed Austin City Limits

The Head And The Heart spent the summer making their rounds at all of the biggest festivals, including Coachella, Hangout Festival, Sasquatch!, Governor's Ball, Bonnaroo, Monterey International Pop Festival, Mountain Jam, Hinterland, Lollapalooza, and Newport Folk Festival, as well as two nights at Red Rocks Amphitheatre.

The Head And The Heart released *Signs of Light* last year on Warner Bros. Records, and it debuted at #5 on the Billboard 200 and #1 on the Rock Album Chart. The Head and The Heart went on to play their hit single "All We Ever Knew" on *Ellen*, *The Late Show With Stephen Colbert*, *CBS Saturday Morning*, *Conan*, *Jimmy Kimmel Live!* and *The Late Late Show With James Corden*. The single "All We Ever Knew" spent 9 weeks weeks at AAA and hit #1 at Alternative, the band's first #1 at the format. Their next single, "Rhythm & Blues," also hit #1 at AAA and the latest track, "City of Angels" recently impacted at radio and continues working its way up the charts.
